FEATURE TOPIC: EU PRE-PRESIDENCY CONFERENCE

On 4 December 2014, more than 100 politicians and scientists came together in Riga to discuss Latvia's working priorities for its upcoming presidency of the Council of the EU starting in January 2015. "Yes, we are ready", stated Lolita Čigāne, member of the Latvian Parliament, in her opening speech at the EU Pre-Presidency Conference. "We are highly motivated for this presidency and we want to work closely together with our European partners to make the best out of it." Along the conference title "Moving the Union forward: Involvement, Growth, Sustainability", Latvia aims at fostering a competitive, engaged and digital Europe.

At the conference, six topics were discussed in single panel sessions: citizens' concerns in a stronger EU, the Union's role in the international arena, European energy policy, the Eastern partnership, relations to Central Asia, and the EU's digital market. The conference was a great chance to reflect these topics from an interdisciplinary and international perspective. Interested young researchers were invited to participate. The conference was jointly organized by THESEUS, the Latvian Institute of International Affairs (LIIA) and the Trans European Policy Studies Association (TEPSA). http://theseus.uni-koeln.de/index.php?id=221.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

PHD WORKSHOP 2014

On 16 and 17 October 2014, the THE-SEUS PhD Workshop took place at Centre d'études européennes (CEE), Sciences Po Paris. Ten postgraduate students of different universities had been selected to present their research works on the topic "The EU after the Crisis", and to discuss these with professors Renaud Dehousse, CEE Sciences Po, and Wolfgang Wessels, Jean Monnet Chair, University of Cologne, as well as with senior discussants.





"The workshop was a great opportunity to receive constructive feedback from fellow PhDs and well-established academics", said participant Alexandra Maria Bocsé, University of Cambridge, after the workshop. "It will greatly help me in improving the theoretical framework and structure of my PhD work." Participant Yoav Shemer-Kunz, University of Strasbourg and Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, described the workshop as "a moment of inspiring exchange of thoughts and a great motivation" to pursue his academic career. THESEUS VISITING PROFESSORSHIP 2014/15

Exploring the characteristics and origins of Euroscepticism - that is, what THESEUS Visiting Professor 2014/15 Céline Belot, Sciences Po Grenoble, does with her students in her current Master seminar "From Europhiles to Eurosceptic citizens: Exploring the EU legitimacy crisis" at the University of Cologne (UoC). Why have we observed a shift of a period of permissive consensus, a kind of indifference towards EU politics, to a situation of growing Euroscepticism since the beginning of the 1990s? What influence did media and political actors have on this development? And: Why do differences exist between citizens' attitudes of the EU across EU member states? Belot's seminar started on 27 October., when Belot also held her public inaugural lecture "The emergence of the EU as a political issue: cause for despair or source of hope for European integration" Fritz Thyssen Foundation in Cologne. In her speech, Belot depicted the term "politization" and explained its development within the EU context. She shared results of one of her recent studies on the French presidential elections in 2012. The study shows that nowadays political parties have to position themselves on EU issues to gain voters support. French citizens who feared European integration





voted for instance for the EU-sceptic Marine le Pen, whereas those who worried that EU politics might erode social policies voted for the left. After her speech, Belot, together with Wolfgang Wessels, Jean Monnet Chair of the UoC, engaged in a lively discussion with her audience on her research as wellas further aspects of EU politization.
